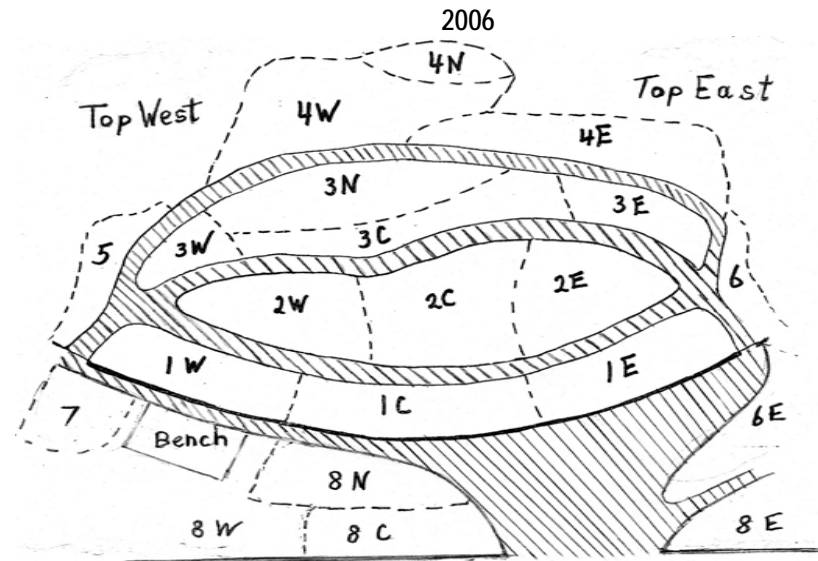

**GARDEN LAYOUT**

The Quarry Garden was developed and is maintained by the Master Gardeners of Northern Virginia, Inc. in cooperation with the Arlington County Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Resources, and Virginia Cooperative Extension. It demonstrates a low maintenance garden suitable for Arlington residences. It is a part sun/part shade garden with many plants native to the U.S. (shown in **Bold** type). Because of the loss of major trees, it has transitioned from a shade garden to a part sun/part shade garden. For additional information on the garden, please call VCE at (703) 228-6414.

The garden has been certified by the National Wildlife Federation as a "Backyard Wildlife Habitat." See section 7 of the garden layout, where we have planted alternative (native) groundcovers as recommended replacements for English ivy, which has become invasive in Arlington parks.
